## **CHANGES TO EXPECT FOR AN OFFICE VISIT**

## When you make an appointment:

- Our receptionist will perform a pre-appointment coronavirus screening to determine if an appointment is appropriate or should be delayed for health reasons.
- Please let our receptionist know if you are currently having symptoms of coronavirus, waiting for test results or have been exposed to someone who has tested positive to coronavirus within the last 14 days.



## When you arrive for your appointment:

- Please call the office prior to entering the building.
- Companions are unfortunately not allowed at this time unless they are a dependent or the person requiring treatment is a dependent.
- Our receptionist will perform another pre-appointment coronavirus screening which is scheduled 15 minutes prior to your appointment with your doctor or hygienist.
- You can expect routine check-ups to take 75 minutes from the start of your screening,
  please schedule your day appropriately.
- A contactless thermometer will be used to confirm your temperature is less than 100.4 degrees.
- If you drive to your appointment, you will be asked to stay in your car until your chair is ready.
  We are doing everything we can to minimize the amount of time that you will spend in the waiting room.

### **Preventative and Elective Care:**

We are open for comprehensive care! We are very proud to say that we have had no transmissions to date at the office and have been working closely with the Baltimore City Health department and following the CDC and ADA guidelines as they have evolved since March.
