CHANGES TO EXPECT FOR AN IN OFFICE VISIT

When you make an

appointment:

• The receptionist will perform a pre-appointment coronavirus screening.

• Please let our receptionist know if you are currently having symptoms of coronavirus, waiting for test results or have been exposed to someone who has tested positive to coronavirus within the last 14 days.



When you arrive for your appointment:

- The receptionist will perform another pre-appointment coronavirus screening.
- A contactless thermometer will be used to confirm your temperature is <100.4 degrees.
- If you drive to your appointment, you will be asked to stay in your car until your chair is ready.
- The waiting room has been reconfigured to accommodate social distancing, we are doing everything we can to minimize the amount of time that you will spend in the waiting room.

Preventative and Elective Care:

At this time, we are not providing routine cleanings or elective treatments (sealants, whitening, esthetic treatments). Incorporating the new infection control protocols into our workflows is an ongoing process with tons of training! Our staff is working very hard to learn new habits and we are taking the next few weeks to get it dialed in. Once the local cases show a statistically significant decline we will be bringing back the hygiene team to make everyone's smile sparkly again! Please call us with any questions that you have.
