Cleanings and Emergencies



We are seeing an increase in upper respiratory symptoms and self-reported COVID cases in our community.

- The current COVID spike in the community is causing significant scheduling challenges. The hygiene team is booked out 4-6 months in advance but has been experiencing a significantly increased same day cancellations.
- If you are trying to get back on the schedule for a cleaning and have a flexible day, call us in the morning or the day before and you are very likely to get an appointment!
- To accommodate all of these scheduling changes, our reception team has been working at sprint for weeks, please be kind and patient with them, they truly are doing their best!
- We have also partnered with WEAVE to enable faster communications. You will see text messages from us the day before your appointment prompting you to fill out a COVID screening. You also may see a form for new insurance information or new appointment save the dates.
- Please do not respond “stop” as you will no longer receive any confirmations and will have to do all paperwork manually.

Covid Screenings

Please do your best to self report symptoms so that we can accommodate your appointments in a way that is safe for the entire community. Covid positive patients can still be seen for urgent and emergent needs but are seen at the end of the day to allow other patients to be seen safely.
